2017 Museum of Teaching and Learning ART AUCTION

You are invited to donate a work of art to be sold at auction during the 10th Anniversary Benefit Gala for the Museum of Teaching and Learning (MOTAL). Learn more about MOTAL at www.motal.org.

Help promote the importance of the arts in education.

Your contribution will help fund MOTAL's teaching mini-grants and the research and development of an exhibit about your brain and learning.

Submit YOUR original piece of visual art to be auctioned at an exciting charity event held at the Bowers Museum. Your work will be shown online in the auction catalog and on the jumbo screen at the event.

Event: *School Days—A "Come as You WERE" Party*

Date and Time: September 16, 2017 at 6:00 pm

Location: The Bowers Museum in Santa Ana, California

MEDIA: Your original work may be a painting, a sculpture, a ceramic piece, a drawing, or a print (woodcut, etching, etc.).

FRAMING: Works on paper must be framed. Works on canvas may be submitted stretched, so not necessarily framed. Each piece must already have an appropriate hanging device. Saw-tooth hangers are not preferred.

VALUE: Asking price should be no less than \$100 nor more than \$5,000. NOTE: winning auction bids may be less than the asking price.

SIZE: Should not exceed 36 x 36 except in rare exceptions to be discussed with the MOTAL auction chairperson prior to the submission deadline.

SUBMISSION:

Send a **photo** of your selected piece including the completed submission forms (attached). Please fill it out carefully and completely. Notice that if your work of art does not attract an appropriate bid, you may choose to donate to MOTAL for their use or choose to be notified to pick it up at the end of the event.

Form 1 is about YOU, the artist. **Form 2** is about your art work.

DEADLINE:

Photo and forms must be received by July 31, 2017, but you may send them at any time after May 1, 2017. You will be notified by August 8, 2017 about your piece being accepted. Your work will be given a brief auction code that should be written on the reverse side (or underside) of the work.

Up to two submissions of artwork per artist will be considered. Acceptance will be based on space constraints, appropriateness for this auction, and other factors. Due to space constrictions this year, only one piece may actually be selected.

FINALLY:

If your work is accepted, a member of our jury will arrange a time for you to bring your work of art to the Bowers Museum on the day of the event (September 16). You will drop off your work of art at the north entrance of the Bowers Museum on Main Street in Santa Ana. There is a parking lot there and you will be guided by clear signage and assisted by careful people.

THANK YOU! You will be given a charitable tax receipt for your donated art work. If you choose to attend the gala, you will be given a 25% discount off a regular ticket. Your work will be insured during the event. In addition, each participating artist will receive a delightful and valuable "Swag Bag."
